Welcome to the 2008-09 Holy Savior Menard art program. We are proud of our efforts to provide an outstanding art experience, challenging students to think creatively. Through a well planned series of projects students learn to research, develop and express ideas artistically as they explore art history, vocabulary, critique, and art production.

Menard provides paints, papers, materials and specialty equipment for a wide variety of art experiences, however **students need to purchase and maintain the following art supplies for their personal use.** These supplies will be used throughout the year and may need to be replaced from time to time. Most of the items are common items located at all stores so with all the special sale prices, you will be able to save by shopping for bargains. There are only a few items which will need to be purchased from an art supply stores like Michaels and Hobby Lobby. Identify yourself as a HSM student/parent and receive a 10% discount at Michaels. You may purchase all of the following items and any items you need/want in addition. Have fun buying your supplies--be creative. *There is nothing like a new box of crayons!*

Each student is responsible for getting these items whether borrowed from the art department or purchased.

Due Monday, August 11 and each day thereafter:
sketchbook, pen and pencil. All additional supply items are due Aug 14.

(Common items needed:)

file folder

hand wipes-soft plastic package/ zip lock bags, quart and gallon size (2 or so of each size)

*glue stick & white glue (Elmers)

E-6000 glue

sharpie--black, fine point

roller ball (gel) pen--black--micro or extra-fine point

*colored pencils(Crayola and Roseart are the cheapest--Prismacolors are the best.)

*markers (Crayola is fine.)

*masking tape

*pencils #2 regular are fine (no mechanical pencils, please)

#6B (must be graphite **not** charcoal or carbon)

(Check art stores for the following:)

pink pearl eraser or Magic Rub

Faber-Castell Art Pen, Black, Fine point

*t-square (12" plastic ruler with a perpendicular bar at one end)

#10 flat brush, Multi-media--short handle (about \$3.11)

#6 round brush, Multi-media--short handle (about \$3.88)

3/4" flat brush, Multi-media--short handle (optional)

Calligraphy pen--black, fine or medium point (felt tip) (**Art I students only)

Foam Core Board (32" x40") (Art II/III only)

Magazines and pictures of interest (from around the house)

sketchbooks-9" X 12" spiral binding-to be purchased in the art room--bring \$6.00

(All students maintain a sketchbook throughout the year.)

*Recycled supplies are available in the art room. As in the past, you may supplement this supply list as you choose.
