Curriculum

The curriculum at Holy Savior Menard is designed for the development of the whole person, vigorously encourages academic excellence, and promotes the traditional qualities of a Catholic education: high academic standards, discipline, personal and community development, and commitment to the gospel of Jesus Christ. The curriculum includes a range of courses, including 3 advanced placement courses and over 70 hours of Dual Enrollment credits.

Graduation Requirements

A total of 27 units are required for graduation with a Menard diploma. A total of 24 units are required for a Diocese of Alexandria diploma and for participation in all graduation exercises.
