Classroom Supplies for Chemistry

Come prepared for the first day of class.

<u>Textbook</u>: Modern Chemistry by Holt, Rinehart and Winston (I provide this)

<u>Four spiral-bound, one-subject notebooks:</u> (nothing more, nothing less, nothing different). Put your name on your notebooks. You may use a laptop or other device, if you choose, but I will ask you to sign a statement regarding the use of these devices.

<u>One spiral-bound graphing notebook</u>: The notebook should be spiral bound on the left side, not on the top. Do not get anything other than the spiral-bound type. This will be used for your lab work for the year, and anything other than spiral-bound will fall apart too easily. Put your name on this notebook.

One pocket folder: put your name on it

Something to write with: Pens (blue or black) or pencils

Something to correct with: Red ink pens

<u>Calculator</u>: Texas Instruments, TI-30XA is the calculator that I use for myself and to teach with. They are readily, and cheaply, available from Walgreen's, Walmart, Office Depot, and Target. This is really all that you need. **Graphing calculators are not allowed.**

One manila folder: put your name on the tab of these folders

<u>Three rolls of paper towels</u>: (do not submit paper towels that have soap in them...these mess up the lab tables and the lab equipment)

Two boxes of facial tissues
