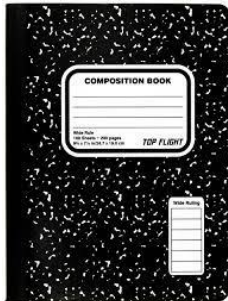
Technology Requirements for 9th Grade Religion

To maintain contact with teachers, staff, and administration, students must have daily access to the following:

- Desktop Computer, iPad, or Laptop • Microsoft Teams app on cell phone (downloaded)
- Internet service
- School Email, Log-in, & Password (All students are given a Microsoft email)

Instructional Materials: Students must have the following in class each day:

- Textbook (online)
- Composition notebook (this kind/brand of notebook ONLY)



- Black or Blue ink ONLY
- Electronic device for work online in class as needed

*****Religion I-Sacred Scripture** will need to purchase a Catholic Bible IF they do not already have one. **The following are Catholic Bibles but are not limited to:**

- New American Bible, revised edition (NABRE)
- Revised Standard Version, Catholic edition (RSV-CE)
- Good News Translation (Today's English Version, Second Edition), American Bible Society
- St. Joseph Catholic Bible
- St. Ignatius Catholic Bible
- LifeTeen Catholic Bible

NOTE: Catholic and Protestant Bibles both include 27 books in the New Testament. Protestant (non-Catholic) Bibles have only 39 books in the Old Testament, however, while Catholic Bibles have 46. The seven books included in Catholic Bibles are Tobit, Judith, 1 and 2 Maccabees, Wisdom, Sirach, and Baruch. These books will be studied throughout the course. The Bible will be marked in which is why the students in Religion I need their own bible for class.
